Antietam Pony Club is proud to sponsor the 5th Mounted Games Challenge, giving all games players a chance to compete for fun in a low stress setting. Use this competition to tune up your pony before games rally, or just as another excuse to play games.

This year, the Challenge will have 5 divisions!!! — Novice (Rising Stars), Jr., Sr., Adv. and Parent. Limit of 12 teams in Jr., Sr, and Adv, limit of 6 teams in Novice and Parent. GRADUATE OR FORMER PONY CLUBBERS ARE WELCOME TO COMPETE IN THE ADVANCED DIVISION. The competition will be run according to USPC Games Rules 2003. There will be no formal inspections and no HM scoring. Height, weight, bitting, saddlery and other such aspects of HM will be in effect. Safety checks will be mandatory for USPC members. Entry fee is \$25 per individual or \$100 for a 5-person team entry. Individuals will be assigned to scramble teams, if possible. If you are entering with other team members, please submit entries together. USPC medical release forms (for Pony Club members only), agreement for hold harmless and release, and current coggins must accompany entries.

<u>Divisions:</u>

Novice (aka Rising Stars) – This division is for players who are brand new to games, are not capable of playing at speed or may need some assistance during play. A helper in the arena is allowed, but not required. Cantering **will** be allowed in this division. Teams may have four or five members. No maximum age, but must be a Pony Club member.

Junior – This division is for all players who are 13 years old and younger. Teams may have four or five members.

Senior – This division is for all players who are 14, 15, or 16 years old. There must be at least one team member who is 14, 15, or 16 but other members can be younger. Teams may have four or five members.

Advanced – This division is for all players who are 17 years old or older. There must be at least one team member who is 17 or older but the other team member may be younger. Teams must have two members. Graduate or Former Pony Clubbers may compete in this division.

Parent – This division is for moms, dads or other grownups that want to get in on the fun of mounted games, but are not capable of playing at the Advanced level. Teams may have four or five members.

Games to be played: Jr., Sr., Adv., and Parent Div - Bending, Sword, Potato, Balloon, Needle and Thread, 5 Flag, **Mug Shuffle (NEW RACE FROM 2003 RULE BOOK)** and either Windsor Castle (if we get the equipment made) or Ball and Cone

Novice Div – Bending, Sword, Mug Race (5 Mug), 5 Flag, Potato (modified – potatoes will be on a barrel, rather than on the ground), Bottle.

Tentative Schedule for Games Challenge (subject to change as circumstances warrant – divisions will not begin before stated time, but may begin after.) Due to the number of divisions we are trying to accommodate, we will not hold the start of divisions to wait for teams or individuals who are late.

- Teams will be pinned directly following play of their division. We will pin to 10th place.
- Volunteers will be needed as line judges each rider should plan to bring one person with them as a volunteer.
- Due to restrictions on the Frederick Pony Club Grounds placed by the insurer of the property (not USPC), we will not be able to serve food prepared on the grounds. We will have coffee, bagels and muffins available in the AM, cold drinks, chips, and snacks available all day. The closest fast food places are about 15 minutes away, so come prepared.
- Please **NO DOGS**. As a courtesy to the Frederick County Pony Club, please bring your own water for ponies. Ample parking is available.
- A limited number of stalls are available if you would like to stall your pony at the grounds. Stall must be cleaned before leaving. Charge for a stall will be \$10.

Directions to Moxley Field from Route 70:

From Route 70 (Frederick or Baltimore area): Take the route 75 exit (New Market). Go north towards New Market to the first stoplight, turn left and go through New Market (2.2 miles), take the first left turn on Mussetter Road (goes back over route 70 to the south), follow Mussetter until it dead ends (after the railroad tracks) at Ijamsville Road, Moxley field should be visible in front of you, turn left and then right to enter.

From Route 270: Take Rt 80 (Urbana exit), turn left at the bottom of the exit ramp, go halfway around the traffic circle, and straight at the light to stay on Rt. 80. Follow Rt. 80 to a left onto Ijamsville Rd. Follow Ijamsville Rd to Moxley field on your left. If you get to the RR tracks, you've gone too far.
