2. **Sock** -White leg marking to above the fetlock
3. **Dorsal Stripe**-dark marking along the back
4. **Blaze**—broad white marking down front of face
5. **Whorl**—hair growing in a spiral shape
6. **Stocking**—white leg marking to the nee
7. **Stripe**—dark marking along the back
8. **Snip**—small white marking on the muzzle

## Holiday Party

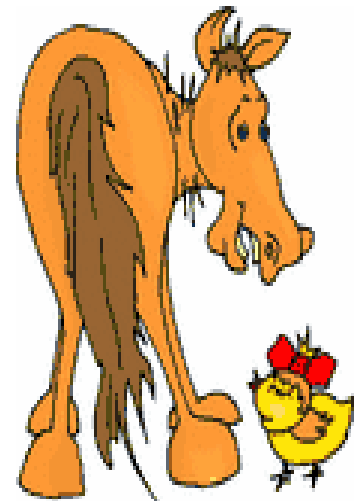
Members, family and friends met for our annual holiday event at the Dreyers home. As always it was such a fun event with awards, prizes and gift exchanges.
